Cockx in December 2015, with Prof. M. Lechner (University of St. Gallen) and Prof. M. Leonardi (University of Milan) in the doctoral examination committee. In 2017 he won a research grant as principal investigator of 468,000 euros funded by the Luxembourg National Research Fund (FNR - CORE Junior scheme).
